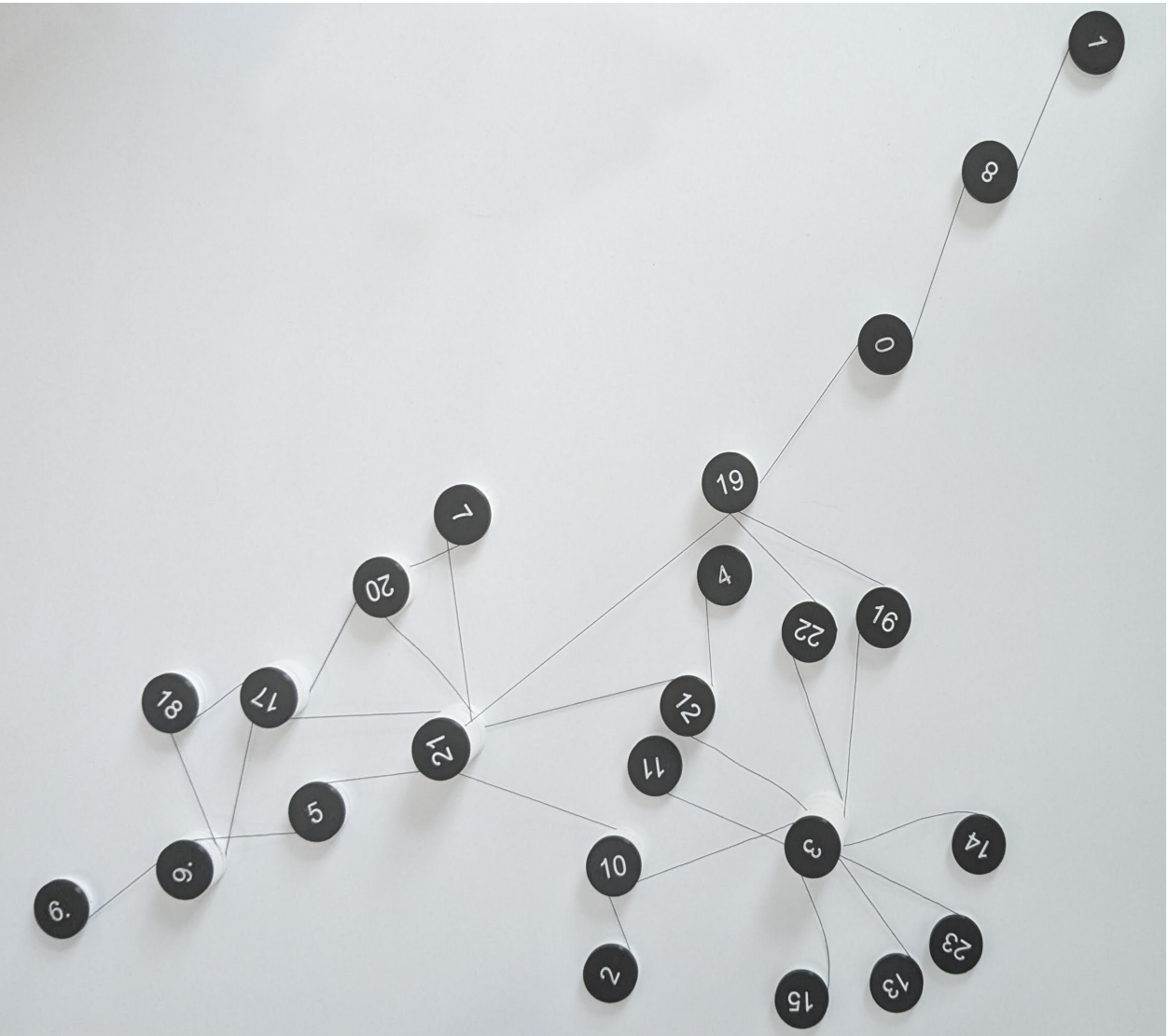
Accessibility (Direct) - Training
